



AHV ANNUAL REPORT COVER ARTWORK COMPETITION 2018

We would like to invite AHV household members, between 5 and 18 years of age, to submit their own artwork, with the winning submission to feature on the cover of AHV's Annual Report for 2017/18.

What is the theme?

This year, NAIDOC Week will celebrate the invaluable contributions that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander women have made - and continue to make - to our communities, our families, our rich history and to our nation,

We encourage AHV's young household members to think about this year's NAIDOC theme 'Because of her, we can!' when creating your artwork. Think about the women in your life who influence you, any activities you might do together or moments you have shared that hold a special place in your heart.

Who can enter?

Entrants must be a household members of an AHV property, between 5 and 18 years of age. Winners will be selected from the below four age categories*:

- 5 to 8 year olds
- 9 to 12 year olds
- 13 to 15 years olds
- 16 to 18 year olds

** your age is determined by how old you are on the closing date of submissions (31 May, 2018)*

What can you win?

Judges will select an overall winner who will receive a gift voucher in addition to their artwork featuring on the front cover of the AHV Annual Report for 2017/18. Winners from each age category will be selected and will also receive a gift voucher. All submissions will be in the running to be used throughout the AHV Annual Report and in other AHV publications, social media and printed materials.

Key dates:

Competition Opens: 1 March, 2018

Competition Closes: 31 May, 2018 (artwork must be received by 5pm)

Winners Announced: 11 July, 2018 - at AHV NAIDOC Family Day

Instructions:

- Only one artwork submission per entrant
- Artwork must be on paper (not cardboard or other materials)
- Artwork must not be mounted or framed
- Artwork must be on A3 paper (420mm x 297mm) - can be vertical or horizontal
- Any art materials may be used to create your piece (eg: pencils, markers, paints) but artwork must be two-dimensional)

Terms and Conditions:

By completing and submitting your artwork and Entry Form, each participant and their parent/guardian agrees to be bound by the following terms and conditions:

1. The artwork must reflect the theme
2. All participants must:
 - a) be a household member of an Aboriginal Housing Victoria property
 - b) be an individual between 5 and 18 years of age (age as at the competition closing date)
3. All entries will be viewed and judged by a selection panel, comprising of AHV staff and board members. The decision of the judging panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into
4. Participants may submit only one artwork (entry) in only one of the following ways:
 - a) Email - send email with completed Entry form and image of your artwork
 - b) Post/Deliver - post/deliver a completed Entry Form and image of your artwork or original to:

5. If a photo version of the artwork is selected by the judging panel, the participant will be required to mail their original artwork for judges to make a final decision and to be professionally scanned for reproduction
6. Aboriginal Housing Victoria accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to an artwork entry as a result of postage, delivery or handling of original artwork
7. A completed Entry Form signed by the participant and a parent/guardian must accompany the artwork to indicate agreement to these terms and conditions
8. All participants must state that the artwork is their own original artwork; and the artwork submitted has not been the recipient of a major prize before
9. All entrants must seek permissions and approvals to reproduce graphics, flags or images of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.
10. Artwork should be no larger than A3 (420mm x 297mm) and must not be framed or mounted
11. Prizes awarded cannot be exchanged or transferred.
12. All entrants (including winners, finalists and acknowledged entrants) grant AHV an ongoing, non-exclusive, royalty-free licence to, a) use, reproduce, publish, distribute, adapt and modify their artwork in all media of expression now known or later developed; and b) the right to use the artists name, age and town or city of residence for the sole purpose of identifying the entrant as the author of the entry. Where reasonable, AHV will attribute the artists as the author of the artwork and reproduce the artwork in full.
13. All entrants' (including winners, finalists and acknowledged entrants) artwork may be used in the following ways (including but not limited to):
 - * Featured on the cover of the AHV Annual Report
 - * Featured and/or incorporated (in full or modified) throughout the AHV Annual Report
 - * Displayed on social media pages and/or website
 - * Featured and/or incorporated (in full or modified) in AHV tenant newsletter
 - * Featured and/or incorporated (in full or modified) in AHV publications and/or brochures
14. AHV reserves the right at any time to modify or discontinue, temporarily or permanently, the competition with or without prior notice due to reasons outside of its control

Important:

If you submit a scanned image or photo of your artwork, **please make sure you keep the original**, as AHV will require the original for professional scanning when using in AHV publications.

Some tips:

If you post your original artwork, please do not fold when putting in an envelope - and where possible include a piece of cardboard to keep the artwork as flat and protected as possible.

If you photograph your artwork for submission, you should keep the artwork flat (preferably against a wall) and try to use natural light (ie: in a bright room using no flash or lights).
