Organisational performance

The Board considered in detail key performance measures outlining AHV's recent organisational performance.

New IT Security Policy and Privacy Policy

The Board noted and approved the new IT Security and Privacy policies which will ensure the protection of AHV's assets and confidential information. The Privacy Policy ensures that AHV is compliant with new Commonwealth Government changes to privacy legislation.
